Awarded Research Grants: We dream of a tomorrow when no parent will fear the words “your child has cancer.” In honor of those children who have lost their lives, and for those children and families that will face cancer in the future, we are investing in research today. We can create **A future without cancer.**

This year we supported 6 research grants to help several brilliant scientists explore cutting edge targeted therapies for treating a variety of pediatric cancers. With matching funds from our Charity Partner, Alex's Lemonade Stand Foundation, your contributions allowed us to direct \$260,000 towards the goal of finding a cure. Our 2013 grants were awarded to researchers at The Children's Hospital of Philadelphia, the Dana-Farber Cancer Institute, the Children's Hospital of Colorado, Mass General Hospital for Children, Nemours Alfred I DuPont Hospital for Children, and the Dallas Children Medical Center. We expect that two of these therapies will enter clinical trials in 2015.



Found Bone Marrow Donors: Through 4 separate bone marrow drives, Cure4Cam has helped add over 1000 people to the bone marrow registry. To date, we know that at least two of those individuals donated marrow or peripheral stem cells to help save another person's life. Those that enrolled in the bone marrow database, and those that donated, are **HEROES** to us.



Inspired Kids to Help Others: As part of our mission, we are finding ways for healthy kids to help those that are not so fortunate. Our volunteers ran several great programs this past year.

Area swimmers held **"I SWAM FOR CAM"** events this year where participants raced against the clock to raise money for cancer research.



Very special young people at several area schools and colleges gave **"GREAT BIG HUGS"** by making blankets for hospitalized children who are battling for their lives. A simple, colorful, soft & warm blanket, accompanied by a message of support from kids their age, lets these patients feel a supporting hug.



"WORDS OF WISDOM" Cameron left us with many inspirational messages and lessons. We have been honored to see local coaches adopt his words, what we call **"CAMisms"**, to motivate students & athletes to work hard and apply their talents to achieve great things.
